

## Pinecone Bird Feeders



Making pinecone birdfeeders is a great family activity. They provide food for our feathered friends and a great chance to birdwatch in your own backyard!

**Here are the supplies you will need:** Pinecones, peanut butter or suet, birdseed, and a string for hanging. If you can not find a pinecone you can also use a toilet paper tube.

### Steps:

1. Spread peanut butter or softened suet all over your pinecone. To soften suet place it in the microwave for 10 seconds.
2. Roll your pinecone in the seeds pressing the pinecone down into the seeds.
3. Hang the feeder in a place you can enjoy watching the birds!
