Approved Grants for 2023 - 2024

\$3,156.75 - NEW Lakeshore Classroom Rugs

Provided funds to purchase 5 new Lakeshore classroom rugs for 2nd Grade Teachers - Brous, Berning & Dietzler, 3rd Grade Teachers - Turman & Kunert. These area rugs will be used daily for students to gather and work. Sit spots on the carpet will help students maintain respectful space while learning. It will also be used during class meetings in order to build community and make the classroom a more welcoming space.

\$179.80 - Passport Club Materials

Provided funds to purchase and order supplies to kick off the program. Budget set did not meet the needs to restart the program and purchase all supplies to allow opportunity for all students to participate in the program.

\$83.97 - Sharpeners for Workroom

Provided funds to replace the pencil sharpeners in the workroom. As the Worker Wednesday program is now back and we have more volunteers willing to come in, we need to replace sharpeners which do not function well.

\$559.86 - (14) Osmo Bases

Provided funds for Technology Class to purchase (14) Osmo Bases to have a full class set. Technology has 4 different OSMO games (words, numbers, tangrams & coding) which is enough games for a full class. The OSMO games all have varying challenge levels and scale with the students, it is beneficial for kids to work individually and at their specific skill level. Purchasing these bases now allows each student to work independently at their own skill level without a partner.

\$663.90 - Please take a seat! - Flexible Seating for 3rd Grade Class (Strobel)

Provided funds for Mrs. Strobel to purchase the students in her 3rd grade class (8) Wobble Stools, (12) Floor Cushions and (6) Plastic Clipboards. Students having options of a variety of places to sit as well as what to sit on has proved to be beneficial to their learning.

\$1,600 - Music Performance Materials

Provided funds for Music Teacher to purchase items for the 2nd and 4th grade musical performances. Purchase will be for (2) backdrops and baseball caps for the 2nd grade. All of these items would be kept, stored, and reused in future years for other classes as they come through 2nd and 4th grade.

\$330.76 - MakerSpace Supplies

Provided funds for consumable materials for the program. Makerspace is a program offered to all students of the school. The frequency of makerspace depends on the availability of materials.

\$332.38 - Kinder Team (2) NEW Incubators

Provided funds for (2) new Chick Incubators for Kinder Team. Eggs are placed in the incubator(s) and wait for them to hatch. Observing scientific phenomena, life cycle/science. This is a yearly project in kindergarten.

Passport Club is a voluntary program for 2nd through 4th graders in which they participate during their lunch recess. Passport Club is a required program for fifth graders.
