Terrariums

Project description: (When will it be implemented? What will it look like? Why do you feel this is important for your classroom or the school?) *

A terrarium is a miniature garden grown inside a covered glass or plastic container. It is an excellent tool for teaching children about the water cycle as it demonstrates evaporation, condensation and precipitation. In the presence of light and heat, water evaporates from the plants through transpiration and from the soil. Since it is an enclosed environment, when the water vapor hits the side of the container, it condenses. Once enough water accumulates or the temperature decreases, the condensation will then precipitate down the sides of the container back into the soil. We would like to implement as part of our Life Science unit in the spring.
