- Respect and honor the by-laws of the SHPTO

Integrity

- Give honest, constructive feedback and value the input of others with respect in mind
- Treat each other fairly

Self Discipline

- Exercise self control in managing stress, anger and our behavior
- Recognize our limitations and those of others
- Use appropriate language that will not offend others

Comradeship and Teamwork

- Work together towards an identified and common goal
- Recognize and acknowledge each others skills and abilities
- Create an environment that is supportive and encouraging to all members
- Promote participation and cooperation
- We encourage participation from varied and diverse backgrounds.

Leadership and Discipline

- Lead in a responsible, patient and motivational manner
- Share leadership through delegation and empowerment
- Defuse conflict by focusing on the issues
